2. Scope of Services

3. Independent Review and Verification

The Subscribing Attorney acknowledges and agrees that:

2. The Subscribing Attorney is solely responsible for independently reviewing, verifying, and evaluating all work product before relying on it or presenting it in any legal proceeding or client communication.



3. The Subscribing Attorney remains counsel of record for their client(s) and bears full professional responsibility for all legal advice given and filings made.
4. While Schill Law Firm takes reasonable measures to ensure the accuracy of citations and legal analysis, the Subscribing Attorney must independently confirm all citations, statutory references, case holdings, and legal conclusions before use.

4. Confidentiality

Both parties acknowledge that materials exchanged under this agreement may contain information subject to attorney-client privilege and/or work product protection. Both parties agree to maintain the confidentiality of all case materials, client information, and work product exchanged under this agreement. Materials will be transmitted via secure channels as agreed upon by the parties.

5. Payment Terms

7. Net 15 from date of invoice.
8. Monthly retainer, invoiced on the first of each month, due within 15 days.

Schill Law Firm reserves the right to withhold delivery of work product until payment is received, except under retainer arrangements.

6. Limitation of Liability

The Subscribing Attorney acknowledges that Schill Law Firm's liability under this agreement is limited to the fees paid for the specific engagement giving rise to any claim. Schill Law Firm shall not be liable for any damages arising from the Subscribing Attorney's failure to independently review and verify work product as required by Section 3.

7. Term and Termination

This agreement is effective upon execution by both parties. Either party may terminate this agreement with 14 days written notice. For retainer arrangements, termination takes effect at the end of the current billing period. Fees for completed work product are non-refundable.

8. Dispute Resolution

Any disputes arising under this agreement shall be resolved through mediation in Santa Rosa County, Florida, before either party may initiate litigation. This agreement shall be governed by the laws of the State of Florida.

9. No Attorney-Client Relationship with Subscribing Attorney's Clients

This agreement creates a service relationship between Schill Law Firm and the Subscribing Attorney only. No attorney-client relationship is created between Schill Law Firm and the Subscribing Attorney's clients. Schill Law Firm owes no duty of care to the Subscribing Attorney's clients.
